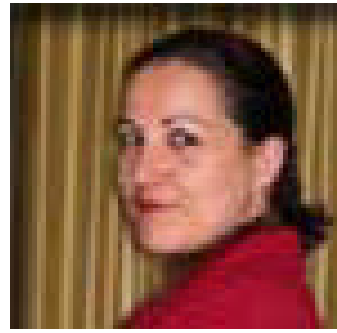

## SATURN: STATIONARY RETROGRADE

The study of astrology is a journey with the cycle of planets and the dynamics of earth moving against the backdrop of the stars.

Last month we focused on our personal Mars energy. Mars in Pisces is now moving forward, forming trines with planets in its native sign of Scorpio. Check your natal

and progressed charts for personal aspects. On October 25th the New Moon is 10° 41' Scorpio. The Sun forms a superior conjunction (full phase) with Mercury at 20° 31' Scorpio. Mars trines the Sun, Moon and Mercury. The symbol for the New Moon is *A broken bottle and spilled perfume*. The issues brought to the surface while Mars was in Pisces are broken, and our inner perfume of love and light has been released to pursue our dreams.

Saturn is retrograde at 13° 14' Cancer. The theme, "Take it slow and easy," is still in force. The message is to practice what we have learned about how to use our Mars energy. Saturn opposes Chiron, giving us more time to take special care of our family and our roots.

Healing takes time and Chiron the healer is giving us a check-up to make sure we are establishing a firm foundation. Mars energy is involved in this opposition since it is exalted in Capricorn and in detriment in Cancer. Jupiter at 12° 4' in Virgo adds its energy to the mix since it is sextile Saturn and trine Chiron. An opportunity to use our energy wisely.

Neptune at 10° 24' Aquarius is direct. At the top of the chart it may be the clue to this month's exercise.

It squares the Scorpio energy, encouraging us to detach from our fears and have faith. The symbol is *A man tete-a-tete with his inspiration*. Stay focused on your vision.

The next day, October 26, the Moon occults Venus – *Hunters starting out for ducks*. "There is a need for an outlet for aggressive emotions." So plan a fun celebration for Halloween to release excess energy in a positive way.
