ABOUT OUR SPEAKER

A popular speaker both nationally and internationally, J. Lee Lehman, has a Ph.D. in Botany from Rutgers University. She is author of *The Ultimate Asteroid Book* (1988), *Essential Dignities* (1989), *The Book of Rulerships* (1992), *Classical Astrology for Modern Living* (1996), *The Martial Art of Horary Astrology* (2002)

and a translation from the French of Papus’ *Astrology for Initiates*. She originated the Classical Studies course curriculum, which presently includes seven regular courses: horary, natal, electional, medical, gaming, mundane and advanced horary. She teaches regular classes in Boston and Amsterdam, and recurring classes in several other cities. Lee is a professor and associate dean at Kepler College. In her spare time, she studies herbalism and Chang-Hon style Tae Kwon Do, in which she holds a 2nd Dan black belt.

In 1995, Lee was the recipient of the Marc Edmund Jones Award, the first horary astrologer so honored. Along with Graham Dawson and Stephanie Johnson of Esoteric Technologies, she has created two software report writer programs written specifically for the classical astrologer: Solar Writer/Medicus for medical questions and decumbitures, and Solar Writer/Classical for natal delineation in the matter-of-fact style of the Renaissance astrologer. Her “Learning with Lee” monthly classical CD learning series provides timeless techniques in the latest technical format.



For any of you who are interested in an analysis of the space shuttle disaster, visit Lee’s website — www.leelehman.com — where she examines both the launch chart of the mission as well as the first flight of the shuttle, which is considered the natal chart of the craft itself.

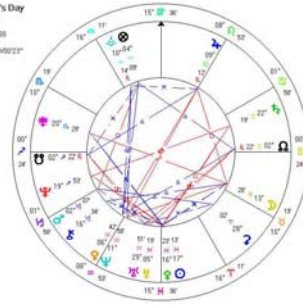
One role of women is to nurture the higher side of Neptune and support unique ways of developing a spiritual life, individually and collectively. On March 3rd Venus enters Aquarius @ the new Moon and conjoins Neptune on March 12th. The Sabian symbol for the conjunction is *A Barometer*. This can be a month and year where we keep track of our inner barometers to see if we're focusing on love for others, spirituality and creativity, or escaping into daydreaming and addictions.

International Women's Day — first celebrated in Germany and other European countries on March 19, 1911* — occurs this year on March 8th. I drew this chart is for 00:01 a.m. in New York City because it's home to the United Nations. A quick look at the four asteroid goddesses gives food for thought.

Vesta is the goddess of the hearth and the eternal flame. In ancient cultures the keepers of fire were responsible for the source of light and heat in the community. Vesta is in Libra in the 10th trine the Venus/Neptune conjunction and sextile Jupiter. Here is an opportunity for women to bring balance to world relationships by focusing on peace at home rather than war in the streets.

Pallas Athene is the goddess of wisdom, creative visualization and manifestation. In this chart she conjoins the Sun in the 4th house, sextiles the Moon and forms a T-square with Pluto and Mars. The empty

leg is Virgo in the 10th. The challenge is to go within and turn powerful ego energy towards creating positive partnerships that benefit both parties. This effort will require planning, organization and attention to detail. The vision can only be manifested by concentrating energy on hard work.

Ceres represents unconditional love and nurturing as seen in the yearly cycles of springtime and new life. In Aries in the 5th in an out-of-sign trine to Mars and sextile Uranus, she reminds us to recreate the gardens of the world.

Juno is the symbol of marriage and commitment. Juno in Scorpio in the 12th opposes the Moon and trines the Sun. The question is — to what are we committed in our heart of hearts?

The rising degree of the chart is 00° Sagittarius 24', *A Grand Army of the Republic around a campfire*. Here is a chance for us to combine our energies with people from around the world to focus on peace.
