

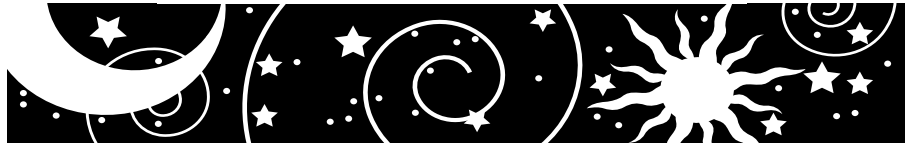

## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Dear Friends,  
March ushers in some major planetary aspects. Let's start with the New Moon that will be on March 7<sup>th</sup>. It is in 17 degrees Pisces 31 minutes. The planet Uranus is currently at 18 degrees Pisces 34 minutes. This is a conjunction. Therefore, this New Moon is sitting with the planet Uranus.

Where Pisces is in your chart is where we keep things veiled. It can be where we suffer. The only reason we suffer in that area is that we have expectations. It is a good idea to have none. It is where we could give unconditionally. That means giving without any expectation of return. It can be where there is unfinished business from the past. This area is where we do charity and have an opportunity to work off karma. We can be imaginative, creative and inspired in this area as well. Wonderful things can come out of this part of you if you are free-flowing and not attached to the results. This is also where

we can pull the covers over our heads and not want to see things as they really are.

As you can see, this area can produce a variety of patterns. Pisces is the sign with no boundaries. That may be why it can contain so many diverse issues. Maybe we could say it is bittersweet. This is why it is represented by the two fish swimming in different directions. Change your attitude about a situation, and the situation changes. This may be what is necessary in this area of your chart.

This New Moon is liberating because of the influence of the planet Uranus. Uranus awakens and changes things. It reveals what has been hidden. You can no longer hide. This is a time when addictions no longer serve the purpose that they once did. Burying ourselves in work, shopping, drugs, alcohol or any other things that take us away from what we really need to see, no longer work.

This New Moon will offer you infinite opportunities for growth. Just stay centered and watch the movie. As it plays out, you will be able to see what you need to see. You will be released from obligations that are no longer necessary for your growth. You are free! What will you do with these opportunities? Will you bury yourself in something else and repeat the same patterns?

Mars was in a full phase on December 24<sup>th</sup>. It was retrograde at 1 degree of Cancer; the Sun was 1 degree of Capricorn; and there was a Full Moon at 1 degree of

Cancer. Also at that time the planet Jupiter had just moved into Capricorn, and it was conjunct the Sun. Mars started this cycle when it joined the Sun on October 23, 2006, at 29 degrees Libra. That would bring situations in our life to the surface that were out of balance, and we would have to face them. This could have been personal relationships or imbalances in any other area. The 29<sup>th</sup> degree gives no choice in the matter.

Besides that, Mars had made an opposition to Pluto on September 21<sup>st</sup>. That in itself is a call for a transformation in some area of your life. While Mars was retrograde, it returned to a second opposition to Pluto on January 2, 2008, and made its case again. Something needs transforming. Mars went direct on January 30<sup>th</sup> and moves to a third opposition to Pluto on March 7<sup>th</sup> at 1 degree Cancer/Capricorn.

This is the same day as the New Moon in Pisces conjunct Uranus. The third time is the charm, or three strikes and you are out. This lunation that unfolds during the month of March offers you freedom and healing. Mars has facilitated this by starting last September, digging up every core issue, so this month could really give us the liberation we need. There has been no wiggle room.

One more thing, Mercury joined Neptune on January 22<sup>nd</sup>. Mercury, the planet of logic, was appealing to the planet of inspiration for answers to the unknown.

### SO THEY TURN YOU ON; CAN YOU GET ALONG? THE USE OF SOLAR AND NATAL CHARTS IN 7TH HOUSE RELATIONSHIP ANALYSIS

Learn to apply both the solar and natal charts to the 7<sup>th</sup> House for an in-depth, three-dimensional understanding of how you and/or your "significant other" function in one-to-one relationships, what your relationship needs are, and whether or not you are compatible.

This is a significantly different approach to compatibility, since most approaches focus on cross-referencing charts for favorable aspects such as Venus and Mars, Sun and Moon, etc. While these are important for attraction, haven't we all learned that attraction alone does not equate to or guarantee compatibility?! Such aspects say little about how you and

another actually behave in a relationship, and must therefore be supplemented by a reading of the 7<sup>th</sup> House.

Special emphasis will be given to comparing the relative importance of signs versus planets.

This will be an actual hands-on, step-by-step application of the lecture material to the charts of those in attendance. Be sure to bring enough copies of your chart for all to share.

## TURN SQUARES INTO TRINES

Spring comes to us in a powerful manner. The equinox is squared by Pluto. In the first 10 degrees, the Sun forms a quinquax with Saturn and a T-square with Mars in the company of the Full Moon.

The Sun enters Aries in Hollywood, Florida, on March 20<sup>th</sup> at 1:48:18 a.m. The Fairchild symbol<sup>1</sup> for the Ascendent of 24 Sagittarius is: *People savoring the smell of warm bread lined up around a block waiting for a bakery to open.* All of us have been waiting and anticipating a new phase in our lives as we

worked through personal issues during the last several months. Where does the equinox fall in your chart?

The next day the Full Moon occurs at 1 Libra 31 making a T-square with Pluto. The symbol for Pluto is 2 Capricorn: *A flag on a speed boat.* It is tempting to rush forward headlong, carrying out our ideas. However, here is a chance to embrace the transformative power of Pluto. The Moon balances the energy, allowing individual fire to be grounded. What revelations have appeared to you in the last six months? Who are the people in your life who have helped you to bring to realize your potential and your abilities?

Two days later on March 23<sup>rd</sup> the Sun and Saturn form a quinquax at 3 degrees 4 minutes. Review and adjustment are required. The Fairchild symbol for Saturn is 4 Virgo: *A midnight meeting between a nature spirit and a priest under the light of a full moon in a sacred grove.* So that the cardinal nature of the

T-square does not get out of hand, the Sun visits retrograde Saturn. This aspect occurs during the disseminating phase of the Sun/Moon cycle. We take the responsibility for grounding the energies in a spiritual and practical way. Where does transiting Saturn fall in your chart? Perhaps that is an area where you may want to focus your energy. What are you willing to share?

Finally, the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter square between the Sun and Moon occurs on March 30<sup>th</sup> at 9 degrees 34 minutes, making a T-square with Mars. Mars opposes the Moon, and the Sun is at the apex of the T-square. This is an opportunity to commit ourselves to new ways of doing and being. Mars in Cancer is ruled by the Moon, and Mars is exalted in Capricorn where the Moon sits. While not a mutual reception, still we can see how the energies can support each other. The pioneering Sun takes charge. Its symbol is 10 Aries: A

*jewelry box with the zodiac carved on it.* Within our personal horoscope is a wealth of information to help us on our journey. All we need to do is to take responsibility for turning our squares into trines.
