

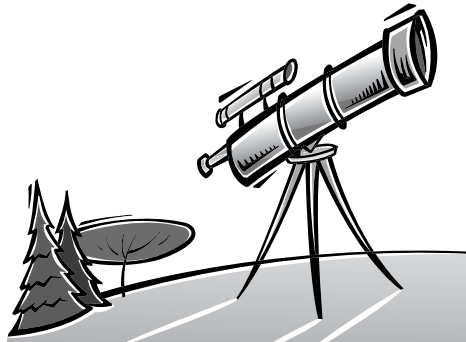

IN MEMORIAM

W. Elizabeth Schuman

Born Feb. 16, 1927

Released Aug. 9, 2004

Elizabeth Schuman was a pioneer in astrology, numerology and health foods. She was a great teacher and mentor, and was devoted to the SFAA for many years. In the late 80s and early 90s Elizabeth was especially active, serving as treasurer and on the board.

The following are excerpts from a letter from her daughter Lynn:

“My mom was a business-woman and an accomplished pianist, singer and ballroom dancer. She was a teacher and astrologer for the last 20 years of her life, assisting many students with understanding life's issues and challenges. During her last move in June of 2004, her ‘most important box to open right away’ was filled with astrological charts and requests from her students for readings. (We thought they would be financial records. Not so.)

“Mom had a strong belief in God and the life after the physical body is gone. Her spirit lives on in each of us: her children, her grandchildren, her friends and her family. She believed that this world is but one step in a long progression of lessons that each of us must master

on our journey to perfection. While she understood that we would feel pain and loss at her passing on to the next plane of existence, she also said that we must not grieve for her — that the next step would unite her with all the loved ones she has also missed so much. She said that she would always be with us, in our hearts and in our minds. She wanted no services to commemorate her passing, but asked that each of us remember her work and her passions, and continue to progress in our journey to understanding and perfection.”

Elizabeth has willed her library of 1,500 books to the SFAA. We are planning an auction, probably at the October meeting, and will share the details through the October *Keyhole* as well as our website, www.sfaa.us, as soon as we can.

SEPTEMBER SKIES

The month begins with Mercury stationary direct on the 2nd at 25 Leo 48. So what have we learned during this last Mercury retrograde?

The last quarter Moon on the 6th at 14 Gemini 21 reminds us of Dane Rudhyar's "crisis in consciousness." September is a month to harvest our summer musings.

On the 10th Mars in Virgo makes a last quarter square with Pluto at 19 Sagittarius 34, and the Sun does the same on the 11th. The questions we might ask ourselves are: What is my attitude towards the question of world peace, power, and terrorism? How will my

attitude affect how we vote in November?

These first two weeks are a good time to prepare for the New Moon on the 14th at 22 Virgo 06. The Sun conjuncts Mars on the 15th. The Fairchild Symbol is 23 Virgo — *An enchanted river and waterfall flowing in reverse*. The St. John's River in New Brunswick, Canada, flows backwards when tides from the Bay of Fundy powerfully rush in causing the river to flow in reverse. One can sit by the window in a restaurant overlooking the river and watch this magical event.* What flows out of us will flow back in.

In this period of reviewing how we use our power, the planetary pair of Saturn and Jupiter jump into the picture. The Sun and Mars in Virgo sextile Saturn at 24 Cancer 59 on the 17th and 18th respectively. This is a lower sextile, an opportunity to gather information and relate the various pieces into a coordinated picture.

On the 21st the Sun conjuncts Jupiter at 29 Virgo

26 before entering Libra.

The Fairchild Symbol:

Treasures found in an antique junk shop. The Jewish High Holiday of Yom Kippur reminds all of us to atone for past mistakes.

On the 26th Mars enters Libra and conjuncts Jupiter at 00 Libra 18. Exuberance for using our personal power to harvest the lessons of the summer. Separating the wheat or treasure from the chaff or trash of our lives. This is Libra's balancing act.

The month ends with the Harvest Moon at 5 Aries 45. The Fairchild Symbol is *Large crowds gather at Washington, D.C., for a demonstration*.
